

National Survey Results 2020 General Election Likely Voters "The China Poll"

Methodology

This survey was conducted among 1,000 likely voters in the United States. All interviews were conducted online between January 27-30, 2020. Survey *invitations were distributed randomly* within predetermined geographic units. These units were structured to statistically correlate with actual voter distributions in a general election. The sample of 1,000 *likely voters has an accuracy of +/- 3.1%* at a 95% confidence interval. The numbers in this summary have been rounded and may not equal 100%.

Some experts note that Chinese companies do not have to comply with the same transparency rules that American ones do with respect to accountability, good governance and risk-disclosure. Should Chinese companies have to satisfy the same requirements as American companies do if they want to raise money in our stock and bond markets?




